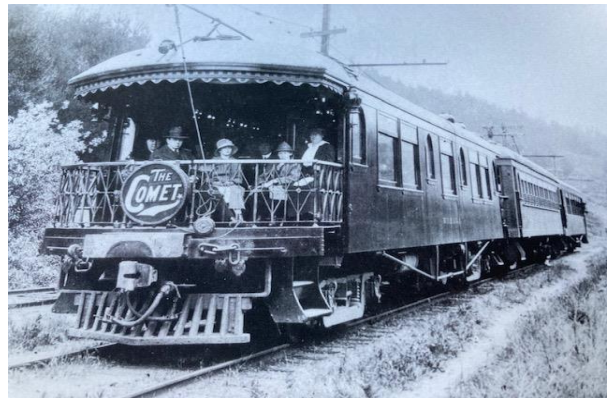


MORAGA HISTORICAL SOCIETY PRESENTS

AND ST. MARY'S STATION.
